



# Grey Street Primary School - New Students Enrolment Processes

Grey Street Primary School is subject to a Designated Neighbourhood Boundary, for new student enrolments. This gives priority of enrolment to students who lives in the Designated Neighbourhood Boundary. The Grey Street DET Enrolment and Placement Policy details these enrolment processes, and can be found on the school's website. This is a summary of the processes outlined in the policy.

**Do you live within the Grey Street Neighbourhood Boundary?**

**YES**

Your child is eligible for enrolment

**NO**

Does your child have a sibling already enrolled at Grey Street, who lives at the same address?

**YES**

Your child is eligible for enrolment

**NO**

Does your family situation involve extenuating circumstances where by you may need consideration for enrolment?

**YES**

Families may apply for special consideration in complex and challenging circumstances (not including financial hardship). An application for special extenuating circumstances can be made through the Principal Team at Grey Street P.S. Each application is considered on a case by case basis.

**NO**

Grey Street have set class sizes and structures to accommodate enrolments. The school must comply with these set enrolment thresholds.

Is there room in the year level threshold I wish to enrol my child?

**YES**

Your child is eligible to be enrolled

**NO**

**Please Note:** New enrolments from outside the designated neighbourhood boundary are prioritised in order of closeness of the house to the school (by shortest practical route by vehicle)

Your child will be placed on a waiting list and advised when a place becomes available.

**Please Note:** Priority is given to those in order of shortest route by vehicle to Grey Street P.S.
