



Placement and Enrolment Policy FAQs

How do I know if we live in the Designated Neighbourhood Boundary?

A map is on the school website for reference.

If my child already attends Grey Street Primary School and we live outside of the Designated Neighbourhood Boundary, does this affect my child's enrolment?

No. Existing Grey Street Primary School enrolments will not be affected.

If I live outside of the Designated Neighbourhood Boundary, does that mean I cannot enrol at Grey Street Primary School?

Grey Street Primary School has set class enrolment thresholds that need to be adhered to. If there is capacity in the year level you would like to enrol your child, your child could be enrolled at Grey Street Primary School.

If we move into the Designated Neighbourhood Boundary during the school year, can my child be enrolled at Grey Street Primary School?

Yes, once you have moved into the Designated Neighbourhood Boundary your child will be enrolled.

I live outside of the Designated Neighbourhood Boundary and wish to enrol my child for next year. When would I be advised of the status of my child's enrolment?

Foundation Level Student – Families will be notified in the first week of Term 4, for enrolment the following year (2019 enrolments – will be notified on October 12th, 2018)

Year 1 – 6 Students – Families will be notified by December 1st for the following year enrolment.

If I live outside of the Designated Neighbourhood Boundary and had a sibling of the child I'm wishing to enrol previously attend Grey Street Primary School, is this considered as a sibling for enrolment?

No. Consideration is only given to siblings currently enrolled at Grey Street Primary School. However if there is capacity within the class thresholds, the enrolment would be accepted.

What are the current Grey Street Primary School class size thresholds?

Foundation – Year 1 – Classes of 22 Students.

Year 2 – Classes of 20 Students

Year 3-6 – Classes of 26 Students

What will happen if the thresholds have been met, when we make an enrolment enquiry, and we live outside of the Designated Neighbourhood Boundary?

Your child will be placed on a waiting list. Priority of placement from this list is determined by shortest practical route by vehicle from your residence to Grey Street Primary School.

What consideration is given to families with a shared care arrangement?

A student's enrolment is considered from the residence of the primary carers address.

What is the process if I believe my family has a complex and challenging situation that may be a consideration for extenuating circumstances enrolment?

All enquiries of this nature will be referred to the Grey Street Principal team and considered on a case-by-case basis.

Will my Foundation level child's enrolment be confirmed before orientation days?

Yes, all new Foundation enrolments will be notified by October 12th.
